Horace Fisher was unlucky in many respects to be a contemporary of Hedley Verity when Yorkshire were looking to replace Wilfred Rhodes. Fisher tended only to play when Verity was on test duty, although he was no mug with either bat or ball as his figures in the Minor Counties Championship illustrate.

But Horace Fisher does have one major claim to fame,

Playing against Somerset at Bramall Lane, Sheffield, in 1932, he dismissed Mandy Mitchell-Innes LBW for 5. His next delivery removed Bill Andrews and so Wally Luckes came to the crease. Fisher's next delivery struck Luckes on the pads and up went the appeal.

Umpire Alex Skelding delayed his decision and then, in a phrase never to be forgotten, announced "As God's my witness, that's out too" The feat has been repeated by Jack Flavell of Worcestershire against Lancashire in 1963 at Old Trafford. His victims were Harry Pilling, Jack Dyson and Peter Lever.

Fisher had begun his cricket career at Denby Grange CC (Wakefield) in 1920 and then with Overton in the Featherstone League. From 1927 to 1929, he was with East Leeds and then Barnsley. After his time with Yorkshire had come to a close, he returned to League cricket for Bacup in the Lancashire League. He also played for Middleton (Lancashire), Yeadon, Windhill, Huddersfield and, finally, Holbeck in Leeds.
