He began with Brodsworth Main CC (S Yorks). Throughout his whole career, he was the opening partner for Geoff Boycott and they added 29 century partnerships together, second only to Holmes and Sutcliffe. He bowled the only over of his career in his final first-class game against Glam at Sophia Gdns on 11-13 July 1984 in the County Championship.

He received his Yorkshire cap in 1974 and had a benefit in 1983, which raised £52,000 (or £176, 629.83 in 2020)

He eventually emigrated to South Africa, having spent several winters coaching there. His son, Michael, was born in South Africa and represented them at U19 level against their England counterparts in 1998/99.

546) **Brian RUDKIN** – No biographical information is available for this player. He was a RH batsman and WK. He played six matches in the Minor Counties Championship between 1968 and 1970.
