In the fine tradition of cricket nicknames, Phil Carrick was always known as "Fergie", after the Irish town of Carrickfergus.

He began his cricket career with Smith Sports CC, aged just 11. He then moved to Farsley in the Bradford CL in 1967, and appeared in their first team, aged just 14. He also acted as professional with Guisborough CC in the North Yorkshire &South Durham CL and had a spell with Pudsey St Lawrence CC, Len Hutton's first club.

He often bowled in tandem with Geoff Cope and had one of his best days as captain of Yorkshire when they won the Benson & Hedges cup against Northamptonshire at Lord's in 1987.

He was to the forefront in persuading the Yorkshire Committee to abandon its policy of using only Yorkshire-born players so that an overseas player could be employed so that, as Carrick himself said "We can fight fire with fire"

After retiring from the first class game, he played for Pudsey Congs, captaining them to the Bradford CL title. He was also beginning a career as a first class umpire when he died, aged just 47, from leukaemia.

He had been awarded his Yorks cap in 1976 and captained the side from 1987-1989. He had had a benefit in 1985 and a further testimonial followed in 1994

He achieved the first-class double of 10000 runs and 1000 wkts for the club and is only the third player to achieve the List A double of 2000 runs and 200 wkts for the club. Chris Old (2572 runs & 308) and Craig White (6384 runs & 248) wkts are the others.
