Lincs v Hunts @ Skegness – 6/7 July (Lincs 231; Hunts 75 & 151) S and result in Haygarth/Bowen MSS) – Presumably the 1<sup>st</sup> game on Ken's list.

Lincs v Norfolk @ Lincoln – 13 July (FS CricketArchive & Haygarth/Bowen MSS) presumably the 2<sup>nd</sup> one on Ken's list. Spalding Guardian agrees.

Lincs v Lord Yarborough's Team at Brocklesbury (Lincs) – 19/20 July (nothing known) From Spalding Guardian.

Norfolk v Lincs @ Lakenham – 3 Aug (FS CricketArchive) the 3<sup>rd</sup> one on Ken's list. Spalding Guardian agrees.

Gents of Notts v Gents of Lincs @ Newark – 8/9 Aug (FS Haygarth MS) The 4<sup>th</sup> match on Ken's list.

Hunts v Lincs @ Hunts – Aug (Hunts made 131 & Lincs 118-6 from Haygarth/Bowen MSS – nothing else known) 5<sup>th</sup> match on Ken's list.

MCC v Lincs @ Lord's – 17 Aug (FS 1882 *Wisden* pp. 73-4; CricketArchive & Haygarth MS) 6<sup>th</sup> match on Ken's list. Spalding Guardian agrees

Lincs v MCC @ Lincoln – 12 Sep (FS 1882 *Wisden* pp. 81-2 & Haygarth MS) Last and 7<sup>th</sup> match on Ken's list. Spalding Guardian schedules this as 30 June.

Ken's lists shows TWO Lincs v Hunts @ Huntingdon (1<sup>st</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> game). We know that Hunts were at Skegness on 6/7 July therefore presumably the other game in Ken's list and should be at Hunts – in Aug. If they are in order in Ken's book it is the 1<sup>st</sup> one which should be at Skegness.

**Lincolnshire Against Huntingdonshire – Skegness - 6,7 July 1881**

Today I went to the British Newspaper Library at Colindale to see if I could track down this missing score. I regret to report that I have not found it. I give the details below of the ground I covered so if anyone else is motivated to do some digging there is no need for duplication. It is a pity that the Skegness newspapers did not appear to start before 1882.

The Lincolnshire newspapers consulted where the score was not found were:

Boston Gazette; Boston Independent; Lincoln Daily News; Grantham Journal; Grimsby News; Lincoln Gazette; Lincolnshire Echo; Sleaford Gazette; and Spalding Guardian.

Also checked was the Nottingham Daily Journal which is good for Lincs matches from 1907 but nothing found.

The Lincolnshire newspapers which I could not consult because they are unfit for use were:

Boston Guardian; Grimsby Advertiser; Grimsby Herald; and Lincolnshire Chronicle.

My last action – which should have been my first - was to see if I could find a fixture list for Lincolnshire matches in 1881.

There is one in the Spalding Guardian for 4 June which lists just five matches to be played:

30 June, 1 July v MCC at Lincoln;  
13,14 July v Norfolk at Lincoln;  
19,20 July v Lord Yarborough's team at Brocklesby;  
3,4 August v Norfolk at Norwich;  
17, 18 August v MCC at Lord's

This contrasts with the seven matches on Trushell's list on p 38 of 'Lincolnshire Cricketers'.
