

MINOR COUNTIES.

A Dunelmian Collapse at Harrogate.

The return match between Yorkshire II. and Durham was commenced in beautiful, sunny weather at Harrogate, yesterday. Both sides were strongly represented. On an uncertain wicket, Tattersall, upon winning the toss, batted first. The game fluctuated in an extraordinary manner throughout the day. Yorkshire had six wickets down for 29 runs, but the last four wickets increased the score to 113.

Durham's innings, however, was consistent in that the whole side batted badly. Eight wickets were down for a miserable 13, and it certainly looked as if the follow-on would not even be saved, but the next wicket was the stand of the innings, no less than 10 being added, making the total 23, the last wicket also falling at this total. The Dunelmians were in only fifty minutes, being disposed of in fifteen overs and four balls. Broadbent and Drake, who had easily carried off the batting honours, adding further to their laurels in bowling, the former taking five wickets for twelve runs, and the latter four for eleven.

As if to show up the Northerners' weakness, the Yorkshiremen batted with supreme confidence in their second innings, 50 going up in three-quarters of an hour, and the hundred in an hour and a half. Smith gave the batsmen the most trouble. Yorkshire finished off with a victory well in sight. Score:—

DURHAM BEATEN.

Easy Victory of Yorkshire Seconds at Harrogate.

When the match at Harrogate was resumed yesterday the Yorkshire team were 218 runs on with five wickets in hand, and they were in what was practically an unassailable position. What hope Durham had of pulling the match out of the fire was practically dead when the Yorkshiremen had concluded the second innings, the Dunelmians having no less than 322 runs to get for victory. Unfortunately, they did not give their supporters the consolation of having even made a good struggle, for they again signally failed with the bat. Broadbent and Drake again proving altogether too good for them.

Only when Turnbull and Coulson were together was there any prospect of a respectable total, but with this pair leaving just before lunch the last chapter was soon finished, the county of broad acres winning in very easy fashion by 234 runs. Broadbent had the splendid record for the match of eleven wickets for 46 runs, and Drake had the almost equally good record of eight wickets for 36 runs. Score and analysis:—
