Glorious weather was associated with the opening stages of this match, at the Swindon County Ground, on Wednesday, and a full day's cricket was witnessed by a fairly large company. Bucks had first use of a perfect wicket, and ran up the useful, though not imposing, score of 184. It never took liberties with the bowling of Smith, Grant, and Mitchell, and the rate of run-getting was generally on the slow side. Matters proceeded very differently at the outset of Wiltshire's innings, G. S. Awdry hitting with delightful vigour until he was caught in the slips. He and Nicholson, who played steadily, made 58 apiece, and subsequently Taunton, R. W.
