The visitors' total was passed with four wickets down, and then ensued a long pattnership between R. W. Awdry and Perkins, who put on 111 before the former was bowled for 52, including eleven 4's. At the close the score was 345 for five.

When play was resumed on Saturday Perkins and Miller scored at a tremendous pace, but just when everybody was expecting the former would complete his century he was bowled for 91—a delightful innings, made without a chance, and which included thirteen 4's. The home captain soon got 50, and Urant rattled up 30. The last wicket added a few, and when Mitchell was bowled the total had reached 472, 127 being added in just over an hour, and the full soore compiled in four hours.
