E. R. SWEET-ESCOTT EXCEEDS THE CENTURY.

CARMARTHENSHIRE COLLAPSE IN SECOND INNINGS.

The Carmarthenshire v. Glamorgan match opened at Llanelly on Wednesday in beautiful weather. Charles Trubshaw was included in the home team instead of Hume Roderick, who was unable to play. Norman Piches and T. A. L. Whittington opened the innings for Glamorgan against the bowling of Jack Davies and E. Geo. Hiles got a couple of singles, and in the last ball of Davies in the first over Whittington was misled by Will Davies. He was ultimately taken by Davies, 23-1-10. E. R. Sweet-Escott was a splendid bat, and exceeded his century. Nash was also in splendid bowling form, securing four wickets for 25 runs, whilst Creber took six wickets for 34. A DECISIVE VICTORY FOR GLAMORGAN.

The Carmarthenshire and Glamorgan match concluded at Llanelly on Thursday, and the result given to the visiting county the honour of a decisive victory. Their splendid batting in the first innings on Wednesday enabled them to secure a majority of 165. E. R. Sweet-Escott exceeded the century. Carmarthenshire commenced their second innings on Wednesday after noon, and with only about half an hour to play, Glamorgan disposed of five men for 19 runs. The innings was resumed on Thursday by C. S. Trubshaw and C. P. Lewis, the former making an additional 20 to his score of the previous evening before he was caught by W. J. Bancroft off Creber. The display of the home county had deteriorated in the second innings, recording 27 runs less than in the first. The trouncing of Creber was brilliant, and he took seven wickets for 33 runs in the second innings, whilst Nash took three for 35. The match concluded about twelve noon, leaving the visiting county victors by an innings and 125 runs. Complete scores:—
