

WILTSHIRE CRICKET.

MINOR COUNTIES CHAMPIONSHIP.

Wiltshire Reaches the Semi-Final.

By its win over Dorset at Wimborne, on Thursday, Wiltshire finished its published list of championship matches. By its successful season, however, it won the honour of again playing in the semi-final at least, and that match began yesterday at Trowbridge, as reported in another page. The four counties left in, as representatives of their respective "groups," to play in the semi-final and (in the case of two of them) the final matches are Wiltshire (southern group), Lincolnshire, Glamorganshire, and Notts II. Last season Staffordshire won the championship, but this year it is headed in its division by Notts 2nd. Wiltshire in two years has won thirteen out of sixteen matches entered upon in the Minor Counties Championship, and lost two only, one of the defeats being on the first innings. Lord Shaftesbury also generously entertained the players on both days. In reply to Dorset's score of 117 Wilts made 188. Upon the home county going in again they shaped very poorly before the bowling of Mitchell and Newman, and were dismissed for 69, leaving Wilts winners by an innings and two runs.

Lord Shaftesbury also generously entertained the players on both days, his lordship's hospitality being highly appreciated. The match resulted in favour of Wilts, who won by an innings and 2 runs. On Wednesday Dorset made 117, and in reply to this total the visitors compiled 189. Mitchell and Newman bowled so effectively on the Dorset men going in a second time, that the homesters were rattled out for 60, leaving Wilts winners as stated.
