Notes: Stafford inflicted a decisive defeat on Northumberland a fortnight after suffering a reverse in Newcastle. In Staffordshire 1st Innings, J.E.Nichols scored 12 4's in his 118 and J.B.Fereday added 6 4's in his 91, these two added 142 for the 5th wicket, a county record against Northumberland. J.S.Heath took 6-56 in Northumberland's 2nd innings on debut.
