DEVON v. SURREY II.

POOR SHOW BY THE HOME COUNTY.
 At Exeter yesterday, Devon continued the last of two important matches this week in the Minor Counties Championship, when they met the second district of Surrey County. In the home town there were one or two alterations in the side which triumphed over Cornwall, whilst Surrey brought a powerful eleven, including no fewer than eight professionals. Devon started their innings on a magnificent batting wicket, but with the exception of Light and Capt. Basalgette, the side gave an ignominious display. Two wickets fell for one run, and the outlook was indeed very black until Light and Capt. Basalgette became animated. The Exeter professional gave a spirited exhibition of batting, cutting and driving with remarkable precision and power. He reached his half-century with a magnificent leg boundary off Myers, but four runs later he fell to a brilliant catch near the pavilion rails. Capt. Basalgette's innings was more patient, but nevertheless invaluable to his side. After the dismissal of these two batsmen, the Devon team collapsed, the innings concluding before lunch for 111 runs.

Surrey passed the home total with the loss of only two wickets, but Harrison, who eventually reached 61, was badly missed at mid-on when he had secured 16, and subsequently at 23. The following batsmen obtained runs freely, but they received every assistance from the bowlers, who were very weak. Vigar going in at the fall of the sixth wicket, hit with tremendous power, and succeeded in reaching his century before being taken at extra-cover by Sturt, the batsman being dismissed by the ball immediately following the scoring of the century. He hit 87 runs &c. The innings closed for 253 runs, Surrey being 251 runs ahead. Scores:—

DEVON v. SURREY II.

GOOD EFFORT TO AVERT DEFEAT.
 The Minor Counties match was continued at Exeter yesterday in splendid weather. Overnight Devon were 251 runs in arrears, and commenced their second innings yesterday with Captain Basalgette and R. Knight. The latter made a powerful start with the bowling, and with eleven runs scored he was taken by Myers. F. H. Carroll followed, and opened animatedly, but runs came steadily, Carroll especially being strong on the leg-side. Numerous changes were made in the Surrey attack, and after the Exmouth amateur had scored 20 he was brilliantly caught by Abel. J. F. Shelley and Carroll then became animated, and Shelley obtained several boundaries. At 17 he was indeed behind the wicket, but this mistake was not an expensive one as 10 runs later he was caught and bowled by Wilkinson. Carroll reached his half-century with a leg boundary off Harrison, and with Light to the cricket he was considerably brightened. The Exeter professional promptly drove Harrison over the screen for 4, and Carroll contented himself with several singles. Light appeared to be well set when he chopped a ball from Myers to point, where he was caught by Wilkinson, half the side being out for 177 runs. Carroll was within one of his hundred when the luncheon interval was taken, and on the resumption he completed his century by sending Harrison to the leg boundary. Davies, after playing a steady innings for 33, was beaten by a ball from Wilkinson, and then Major Garratt and Carroll saved the home county from an innings defeat. The third century was reached after just over three hours' play, and of this score Carroll was credited with 150. With the score at 253 Major Garratt was caught at mid-on, after putting on 27, and eight runs later Carroll succumbed to a catch in the slips by Abel off Flatt. His 170 included twenty-six 4s. The Surrey first innings total of 252 was passed with H. G. Freeman and W. Wreford in partnership, and runs were coming pretty freely again when, at 297, Wreford was stumped by Vigar, after scoring 31. The innings closed almost immediately after for 253, leaving Surrey 145 to win, with two hours left for play.

The visitors' innings was opened by Harrison and Myers, and with only 7 registered Davies caught Myers behind the wicket off Christian. Abel partnered Harrison, and the batsmen began to drive pretty freely, but at 24 Abel was clean bowled by Wreford, which, with his excellent bowling, however, failed to make any further impression, and half an hour before time Surrey were winners by eight wickets.
