MINOR COUNTIES CHAMPIONSHIP.

CORNWALL v. BERKSHIRE.

This match was begun at Truro on Wednesday. Berkshire went first to the wickets, and made a moderate start. They lost seven wickets for 95 runs, but Nepean and Lockhart made a fine stand, the former scoring 55 and the latter 40. This completely altered the complexion of the game, the last three wickets realising no fewer than 128 runs. Cornwall batted very moderately, the innings closing after two hours' play for 118. Being 108 runs behind, Cornwall had to follow on, and when stumps were drawn, after 1½ hours' play, were 28 runs on with five wickets in hand. Scores:—

MINOR COUNTIES' CHAMPIONSHIP.

CORNWALL v. BERKSHIRE.

For this match, which opened at Truro yesterday, Cornwall made two alterations in the team which defeated Kent 2nd XI. last week, Coed and Hawken, both of Lanhedock, taking the places of Pridoux and Wilson. Berkshire batted first, and with 50 up Bennett was well caught in the slips off Treverthen, and Shoosmith was not long in also returning. Brougham, who batted ninth for 26, was splendidly caught at mid-off by Whiting, but the Pensance professional twice missed Strange during the stand that player made with Belcher. However, Whiting took the latter's wicket with the first ball delivered on his relieving Hawken, and very soon dismissed Strange as well. He was further responsible for Woodburn's downfall. Seven wickets were down for 36, and the century went up after 56 minutes play. Nepean and Lockhart made a fine stand. At 110 Treasna relieved Treverthen, and Lockhart lifted him out of the ground for six, and a little later the Cambridge man hit Whiting into the corner near the entrance to the ground, where he was brilliantly caught by J. C. Rickford-Smith, though luckily for Berkshire the fielder had passed the boundary before the ball reached him. At lunch the score was 160 for 7 wickets. On the resumption the score rose steadily until at 174 Lockhart sent an easy catch to Hawken. His 40 runs were made without a chance, and included two 6's and four 4's. Hawksworth was by no means comfortable during his short stay, and then another good stand was made, Todd helping Nepean to take the total to 226, when the latter was dismissed with a fine left-handed catch in the slips by W. N. Bickford-Smith. The last three wickets realized 128 runs. Nepean's 55 included a six and seven 4's. Coed and Whitworth opened the home county's innings and both batsmen played cautiously. At 17, however, the Lanhedock man was bowled by Belcher, and in the next over Hawksworth captured the Truronian's wicket. Treasna soon hit up 15, bringing on Lockhart with his "googlies," and in his first over he got Treasna and Vibart. The batsmen were always in difficulties, Manswell and Homer alone making any stand, and the innings closed for 118, having lasted two hours. Cornwall had to follow on 108 runs in arrears, with 1½ hours left for play, and when stumps were drawn were 28 runs on with five wickets in hand. Scores:—

In Cornwall's first innings Lockhart took 5 wickets for 49 and Woodburn 2 for 27. Hawsworth (6 for 47) and Belcher (3 for 41) did best in the second attempt.
