CRICKET.

BUCKS v. GLAMORGAN.

This match, in the Minor Counties' Championship, was played at Aylesbury on Friday and Saturday in last week, when, after an exciting game, the visitors won by eleven runs on the first innings. On Friday there was a large attendance of spectators, including between 200 and 300 guests of the Rev. C. O. Phipps and Mrs. Phipps, who held an "At Home" on the occasion, it being the first county match since the organisation of the Aylesbury Sports Club. Bucks won the toss, but they made a bad start against the fast deliveries of Hacker and the deceptive slows of Creber. However, on Mat Wright and Le Gras becoming associated a brilliant stand was made, and through the fine batting of these two and useful contributions from Franklin, Shaw, and Ross, the respectable total of 274 was reached. Whilst the visitors were able to exceed this, they were wholly indebted for their gain of three points to the play of three men. Whittington, Jones, and Riches all played good cricket, and scored freely against good bowling and brilliant fielding. In a second innings Bucks lost five wickets for 63 runs, of which Frith made 37 not out, when rain brought play to a close. Score:—

SOMERSET v. WORCESTERSHIRE.

Played at Taunton on August 10, 11 and 12 and won by Worcestershire by seven wickets. The Somerset bowling, in the absence of Lewis and Robson, was very weak and the visitors' total of 473 did not come as a surprise. Neither Foster nor Arnold gave a chance, and the former, during the two hours and three-quarters he was in, hit two 6's and nineteen 4's. Foster added 95 with Pearson and 108 with Arnold, whose stand with Cuffie for the fifth wicket realised 131 in 65 minutes. Against Burrows Somerset's first innings closed for 246 in three hours and a-half, only Bisgood and Samson making much headway. In the follow-on Bisgood and Hardy made 118 in two hours for the first wicket, and subsequently Daniell, who batted three hours without a mistake and hit nine 4's, put on 65 with Johnson and 81 with Braund. Worcestershire were set 126 to win in 85 minutes and, Bowley hitting hard, made the runs for three wickets. Bowley and Burns made the last 81 together without being parted. Worcestershire won five minutes before time, making the last 26 runs in five minutes. Score and analysis:—

Played at Leicester on August 10, 11 and 12 and won by Leicestershire by an innings and 20 runs. It was certainly somewhat strange that Leicestershire should obtain their first success of the season at the expense of Yorkshire, whom they dismissed for their smallest total of the year. King bowled with remarkable success, taking seven wickets for 5 runs on the third morning and obtaining his last five in 20 balls without a run being scored. Leicestershire were put on the way to victory by Wood and Boden, who added 87 together after two wickets had fallen for 20.
