MINOR COUNTIES COMPETITION.

DEVON v. DORSET.

At Exeter yesterday Devon commenced a return match with Dorset, who the previous week, at Sherborne, gained a one innings' victory over the Devonians. There were five alterations in the home eleven, while Dorset made two changes in the team that did duty at Sherborne. Devon won the toss, and opened on an easy wicket. Orchard and Ball batted first, while Sewell and Cummins shared the attack. Runs came slowly at first, but Orchard quickly settled down, and reached the boundary on numerous occasions, a fine stroke to leg seeing him pass his half century after an hour's play. Ball was playing very cautiously, but when the score was two runs short of the hundred he got his leg in front of a delivery from Sewell and was given out when he had scored 23. After the luncheon interval Orchard was cleared bowled by Gordon in his first over, and Major Garratt joined F. H. Carroll, only to leave again without a run to his credit. The score had increased to 177 before Carroll was out leg before wicket to Webb, and without increasing the score Davies was out in a like manner. Shelley partnered Light, and before the former had touched the ball he had his middle wicket removed by Cummins. Devon concluded their innings of 205, Tate having his middle stump hit clean out of the ground by Cummins with seven to his credit. Dorset's innings opened with an hour's dull and uninteresting cricket, and when the total stood at 52, Sewell, who had made 23, was finely caught by Shirler at deep field off Light, who was responsible for four more wickets before stumps were drawn. Not, however, until a substantial score had been made was his bowling effective, and then wickets fell fairly fast. Dorset had managed to pass the home total by one run when play was stopped for the day, the visitors having two wickets to spare. Score:—

VISITORS REGATE DEFEAT.

This match was resumed at Exeter yesterday an early start was made, and the Dorset innings closed at 11 o'clock for 202 runs. Devon's batting at the second attempt was of an indifferent character, and at one time it appeared as if the side were going to collapse. This was after Light had been bowled, and Ball unfortunately ran out after playing a great innings of 55. Light's stand with Ball had put on 70 runs, and since other Major Garratt was clean bowled by Cummins, Shelley and Davies added a few runs, but at 141 the former gave an easy chance, and one run later Devon got his leg in front of a ball from Sewell. Cummins, however, was overtopped by the Hon. D. Acott and Tate, who added 20 runs for the last wicket before the North Devon amateur had his off stump removed by Cummins. Requiring 250 to win, Dorset did not make a very suspicious start, losing four wickets for 20 runs. Encouraged by the spectators when the home team had secured nine of Dorset's wickets for 175, but Manser and Patey got together and held on the wicket until Manser arrived. The game therefore ended in a draw, but Dorset secure three points on the first innings and Devon one point. Score:—

Shelley and Davies added a few runs, but at last the former gave an easy chance, and one run later Davies got his leg in front of a ball from Sewell. Cummins, however, was averted by the Hon. D. Scott and Light who added 80 runs for the last wicket before the match. Devon amateur had his stump removed by Cummins. Requiring 95 to win, Dorset did not make a very auspicious start, losing four wickets in the first ten minutes. The game then began to rise again, and the Devon batsmen had secured nine of Devon's wickets in the first ten minutes, but Manser and Patey got together and held up the wicket until time arrived. The game then ended in a draw, but Dorset secured three points on the first innings and Devon one point.
