FRESHMAN'S SUCCESS.

FINE BOWLING IN LOCAL VARSITY MATCH.

Nottingham University College beat Birmingham University in a two-day match at University Park, by 33 runs, and have now won two and drawn one of their matches this season. In their first innings Nottingham batted 21 hours for 107, of which Hood contributed 41, C. P. Loney, the Derbyshire left-arm bowler, took four wickets for 31.

Birmingham, in their first venture, totalled only 82 on a difficult wicket, of which H. S. Goodwin, the Staffordshire county batsman, was top-scorer with 29. C. P. Sriwardena and A. R. Steele each captured two wickets for 30 runs.

In their second innings Nottingham put together 96, and Birmingham set to get 121 to win scored 87 on a badly-worn wicket. C. P. Sriwardena, a Ceylonese "Freshman," secured six wickets for 41, making a match total of ten wickets for 71. MINOR COUNTIES' CRICKET.

LANCASHIRE ENTERTAINED AT FOREST TOWN.

NOTTS. II. EASILY DEFEATED.

For the third season matches in the Minor Counties' Championship are being played at Forest Town, and on Wednesday and yesterday Lancashire II. were the visitors. With the score 103 for five, players were driven to shelter.

The innings came to a close at 161. Leicestershire winning by an innings and 48 runs. Dixie Smith took five wickets for 63.
