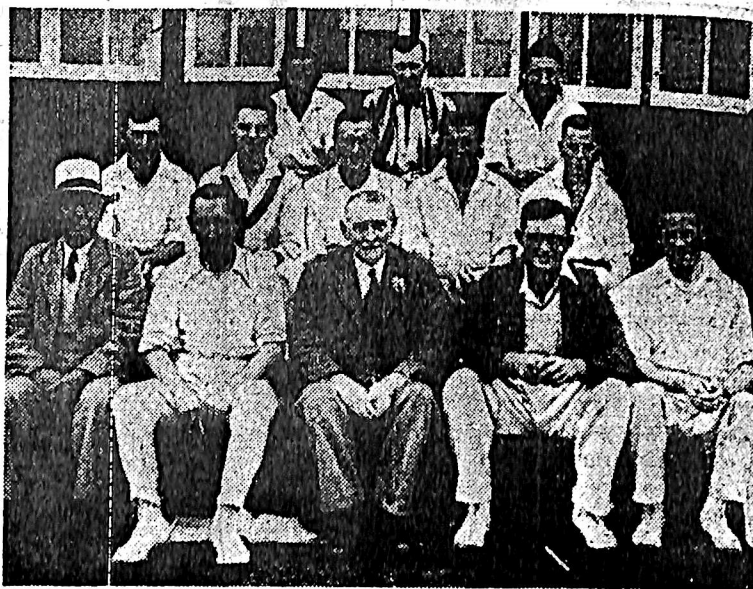

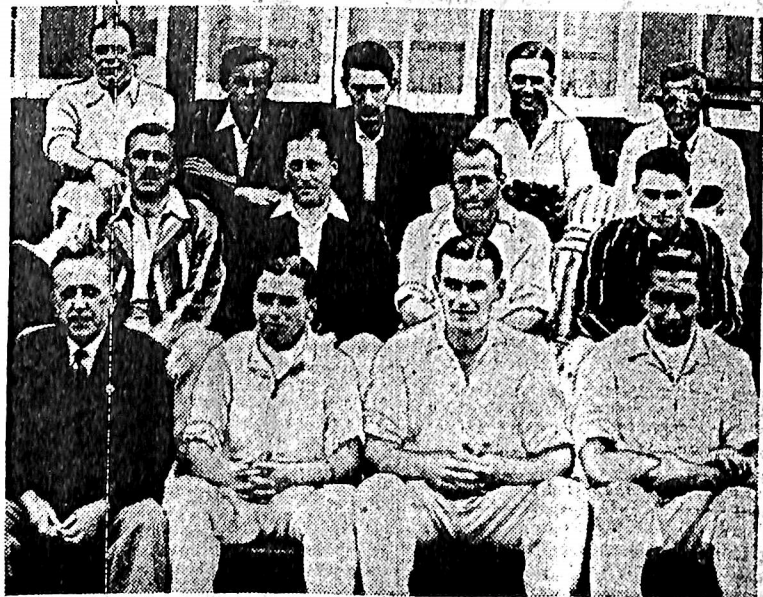

"I see nothing but danger in such an innovation proposed," declared his lordship. "It is setting up a dangerous precedent. It is opening the way for clubs and captains to throw challenges about regardless of authority."
