Died 1 Nov 1917 in Boulogne-sur-Mer, Pas de Calais, France. He is buried at Wimereux, also in the Pas de Calais.

First Class debut – v Derbys at Queen`s park, Chesterfield on 7-9 June 1906 (County Championship). His Yorks career lasted from 1903to 1906.

His highest first-class score (11) was made against Notts at Trent Bridge on 21-23 June 1906 (County Championship).

79) **C H HEDDON** – No biographical information is available for this player. He played just one Minor Counties Championship match against Northumberland at Ripon CC on 23 & 24 Aug 1906. He scored 17 and 11. He did not bowl and did not take any catches.

80) **Cecil Harry PARKIN** – Born 18 Feb 1886 in Eaglescliffe, Co Durham. He had one season with Yorks (1906) until this accident of birth was discovered. However, Lord Hawke was also born outside the county boundary, in Willingham by Stow, near Gainsborough in Lincs. He died on 15 June 1943 in Cheetham Hill, Manchester, aged 57.

He was a RH batsman and LB and OB bowler.

Test debut – v Australia, Sydney CG, 17-22 Dec 1920.

First Class debut – v Glos, Headingley on 2-4 July 1906. This was the only first-class game he played for Yorks before his career resumed in 1914 with Lancs, for whom he played a further 163 first-class games, up to of the 1926 season.

Yorks career – 1906. After he left Yorks, he played Minor Counties cricket for Durham from 1907 to 1913 before joining Lancs.

His highest Test score (36) came in his fifth test, which was, in fact the fifth test of the 1920/21 Ashes series. This game was also played at the Sydney CG, as only there, Melbourne and Adelaide were used for this five-match series.

His best test bowling figures (5/38) came against Australia at Old Trafford on 23 to 26 July 1921.

His highest first-class score (57) was made against Kent at Old Trafford on 7-9 June 1922 (County Championship)

His best first class bowling figs (9/32) came in the game against Leics at the Bath Grounds, Ashby-de-la-Zouch on 21-24 June 1924 (County Championship)
