112) **Edgar OLDROYD** – Born 1 Oct 1888 in Healey, Batley, W Yorks76.

Died 27 Dec 1964 in Truro, Cornwall, aged 76.

He was a RH batsman and RA off-break & medium-pacer

First-class debut – v Sussex, The Circle, Hull, 28-30 July 1910 (County Championship)

Yorks career – 1909-1931. He was awarded his Yorks cap in 1921 and a benefit season in 1927.

His highest first-class score (194) came in the County Championship game against Wores at New Road on 9-11 May 1923

His best bowling return (4/14) also occurred in the County Championship game against Glos at the Circle, Hull, on 23-25 June 1926. Both were career-best performances.
