It was not until the partnership began between A. E. Walker and C. Pickersgill that scoring really commenced, and they carried the total from 9 to 37, and later on Henderson and Morris made matters comparatively lively, and lifted the score from 47 to 84. These were the only batsmen to make anything of a stand, and when the innings finished with a total of 84 it had occupied only two hours and ten minutes, excluding a stoppage from 12.30 to 4.30, owing to rain. SENSATIONAL PLAY.

The match in the Minor Counties Competition between Durham and Norfolk at Sunderland had a sensational opening yesterday, and when the day's play concluded, the visitors found themselves in a very favourable position. The wicket looked fairly easy at the start, and in winning the toss Durham took first innings. The team was considered the strongest batting eleven placed in the field this season by the northern county, and consequently the disastrous start was all the more inexplicable. Allsopp and Falcon were the bowlers, and the first four men, who rank among Durham's crack batsmen, failed to score, and half the wickets went down for only 8 runs. A remarkable fact was that the first hit was made by the sixth man in, A. P. Ashley, the score before his arrival consisting of two byes. An hour before luncheon time, when the score stood at 18 for five, rain stopped play, which could not be resumed until twenty minutes past four. The wet making the ball slippery, the batsmen had an advantage over the bowlers, and useful partnerships took place between A. E. Walker and C. Pickersgill, who made 28 white together, and between Hendren and Morris, who by spirited cricket made 25 white together. The other men were of little value, and the innings, which occupied two hours ten minutes, produced 84 runs. The total, though considerably better than the opening had promised, was a poor one, and Durham's show at the wickets was exceedingly disappointing and unaccountable to their supporters. Norfolk were left with about an hour to bat. In it they made 51 for two wickets. Their innings started with a mild sensation also, Thursday placing his first into the slips, where Hendren brought off a very smart catch. Morris was the bowler, and in the same over G. A. Stevens lifted one of his deliveries over the rails for 8. Norfolk were certainly masters yesterday.
