## CRICKET.

### DORSET v. CARMARTHENSHIRE.

Carmarthenshire, who in their first innings against Dorset at Stradley led by 32 runs, resumed their second innings on Thursday, and when only eight runs had been scored Capt. D. Hughes Morgan was caught by Hodges off Woolley. The vacancy was filled by Percy Rees, who played excellent cricket. Considering the state of the wicket, his contribution of 33 runs, which included a hit for six, was highly satisfactory. When A. P. James appeared, however, runs came at a far faster pace. His total included 2 sixes and 5 fours. Another batsman who scored freely was G. Gravelle, who, it will be remembered scored 152 against Cornwall. In this match he contributed 30 runs before being caught and bowled by Cummings, who was the most successful bowler in this innings taking four wickets for 27 runs. The last wicket stand by Wheldon and C. P. Lewis was remarkably good. The latter, who is a veteran in the Carmarthenshire team, hit out fearlessly, and carried his bat out after scoring 23 runs. His partnership with Wheldon realised 60 runs.

Dorset started their second innings with no less than 246 runs to win, and they realised their task was hopeless. They, however, played gamely. The only player who succeeded in knocking up a good score was Hodges, whose total of 30 included 6 fours. Dorset's second innings was brought to a close after 1½ hours' play, Gee having taken five wickets for 40 runs, Hugh Howell four for 35, and A. P. James one for 4. Carmarthen won handsomely, having a margin to their credit of 162 runs. Scores:—
