HEAVY NORFOLK SCORING.

CAMBS. AGAIN BADLY BEATEN.

Cambs. commenced the first match of their Eastern tour on Wednesday at Norwich, with rather a weak side. Norfolk are admittedly a very fine side, and are just now right on the top of their form, but that does not account for the poor exhibition made by the Cambs. team.

The visitors made numerous alterations from the side that opposed the M.C.C., A. S. Ling, C. Pigg, G. Rose and B. W. Pigg being absent. Norfolk made two alterations from the side which gained such a sensational victory over Notts II, Treglown and Pilch coming in for Collinson and Beresford.

Cambs. won the toss, which in two-day matches should be a great advantage, but they failed to make the most of it, although Norfolk made several blunders in the field, and dropped catch after catch. After lunch, however, the Rev. G. B. Raikes found his form, and carried all before him, securing five wickets for 21 runs, his victims including Hayward, Tebbutt, Watts, Coulson and Sheldrick, the last four batsmen only obtaining five runs between them. The feature of the Cambs. innings was undoubtedly the splendid batting of Frank Hayward, who has seldom been seen to such advantage. The Rev. Raikes followed up his bowling with an excellent 83, but this was passed in brilliance by Stevens' 74, scored in an hour. When stumps were drawn Norfolk were leading by 140 runs, and had only lost half of their wickets.

Play was resumed on Thursday, in splendid weather. Norfolk completed their first innings, and before they were disposed of brought their full total up to 414. Cambs. entered on their second innings 225 in arrears, and made a most disastrous start, five wickets being down for 25.

After lunch Tebbutt and Watts made a stand, and added 56 in 20 minutes, but with these two out the innings closed for 94, Norfolk winning by an innings and 131 runs. Gibson took six wickets for 30 runs.
