A BOWLER'S WICKET.

VISITORS CHEAPLY DISMISSED.

The sun was shining, but a strong wind was in rather unpleasantly strong evidence this (Friday) morning when Lincolnshire met Bedfordshire in the People's Park. Heavy rain the night before had its result in a slow and tricky wicket. Both teams were only moderately represented, and H. Sheckell was the only Grimsby man playing for Lincolnshire. Bedfordshire won the toss, and decided to bat first. Holdstock and Wharmby opened the innings, facing the bowling of Geeson and Day.

Play was slow until the batsman appeared to get a fairly good hold of the bowling, and eleven overs had been bowled before twenty runs were up. Then Riley re-placed Day, while Worman went on in Geeson's stead. In the fifteenth over of the match Worman clean bowled Wharmby, when the latter had only 8 to his credit. Holdstock had been doing the run getting. This made 26 for one.

Then things began to look happy for Lincolnshire. Orr had replaced Wharmby and was only just beginning to settle down, when two overs and two runs later Riley got home on Holdstock's wicket—28 for two. 19 of them from Holdstock. Uphorp followed, and narrowly missed being caught and bowled off the next ball. However, his life was short, and not uproariously merry. He had only had about time to find what the People's Park pitch was like when he snicked a ball from Riley into the hands of Allen, the wicket-keeper. It was a smart catch—36 for three.

A PROCESSION OF BATSMEN.

The game then began to degenerate into a mere procession to and from the wicket. With his very next ball Riley clean bowled Leventhorpe. Truly it was a treacherous wicket with a vengeance. Still they came—and went. With the fourth ball of his next over Worman disturbed E. Grierson's stumps. Two ducks in succession, and the score five for 39! Not exactly bright for County cricket!

T. W. Saunders came next, and stayed long enough to get no runs and fall to Riley in the next over, being caught by Worman in the slips. This was six for 40. Orr, with 11 not out to his credit, began to develop into a hero. Peel followed Saunders, and managed to stay with Orr considerably longer than his predecessors. In some fifteen minutes they put on 24 runs, when Orr fell the victim to the rather more vigorous play he had been indulging in, and was clean bowled by Day in trying to make a big hit.

THE HIGHEST SCORE OF THE INNINGS.

He hit two fours and a three in compiling 29, the highest score of the innings. In the circumstances, it was a total on which he deserved to be congratulated. Peel was caught in the slips after making 8 runs. Brown and Gutteridge quickly followed, and Pilgrim was left not out for seven, when the innings concluded for a total of 76.

RILEY'S BOWLING.

Riley altogether covered himself with glory. His fast deliveries were responsible for the fall of six wickets for 28. Day took two for 14, and Worman two for 23.
