DEVON v. CORNWALL.

**FOUR START BY THE CORNISHMEN.**  
Tropical weather prevailing at Tavistock yesterday when Devon commenced their home fixture with Cornwall on the Kelly College ground. The wicket was in capital condition but Cornwall, on winning the toss, started disastrously against Light and Freeman, four wickets falling for 15 runs. Up to the fall of the third wicket nine overs had been bowled, of which seven were maidens. E. Bickford-Smith and Treawna made a better stand, but it took the Cornishmen three-quarters of an hour to reach a total of 30. Bickford-Smith's fate came at the hand of Robinson, the Cornishman by contributing a valuable 18 having with Treawna set the visitors on a better footing. Another smart 18 was contributed by Maunsell, who placed the ball about freely until dismissed leg-before. Prettily indeed did Davies stump Romer. The century was signalled after nearly two hours' play, and at the luncheon interval the visitors had scored 104 for the loss of seven wickets. Reversing, Treawna and Hawken made a good partnership, 58 runs being added before Light dismissed Treawna with a delightful catch in the slips. Treawna's 71 was an invaluable innings, and he batted in very good style throughout. Another smart catch was effected by Russell, who held Hawken well at mid-off, and Basalgette caught Whiting, but the umpire had signalled a "no-ball." With Whiting clean bowled by Wroford, Cornwall's innings concluded for 168.

Devon's account was opened by Captain Basalgette and E. C. Ball. Both hit out well until the score had reached 40, when Vihart caught Basalgette at the wicket. Trevarthen next smartly caught Ball in the slips. Burdett signalled his appearance at the wicket by putting the ball out of the ground off the first and third balls he received. At 111 Carroll was caught at mid-off, having made 41 all round the wicket. Light's stay was short. He had compiled 18 when caught at the wicket of Treawna at 142. Bickford-Smith badly missed Burdett at 205, and at 6.30 Devon had compiled 260 for the loss of four wickets. Burdett's contribution so far being 115, and Russell 40.

DEVON v. CORNWALL.

**HEAVY REVERSE FOR THE CORNISHMEN.**  
The chief feature in yesterday's play in the Devon v. Cornwall match at Tavistock was the brilliant display of batting by Burdett, who the previous night had scored 115, not out. Continuing to play a free, open game, he hit times and fairs to abundance. He, however, gave several chances during his long innings of 221, which included eight 6's, twenty-five 4's, and five 5's. He was caught at point by Coed. Russell concluded his innings of 40 by being caught by Whiting. The Devon captain contributed 13, and Davies 21 to an innings, which was declared closed at 418 runs for 8 wickets. This left Cornwall 251 to get to avoid an innings defeat. Whitworth and Treawna opened, but the former was neatly dismissed at 30 by Wroford at the cost of 12 runs. Only eight runs had been added to the total when Light scattered Treawna's wickets, that player having contributed 15 to the score. Trevarthen was sent out, being clean bowled by Freeman for a well-earned 15. Cornwall were 77 up for the loss of three wickets, but the next three wickets fell for the addition of 44, and the remainder went down very cheaply, the Cornishmen being all out for 151. Devon thus winning by an innings and 100 runs.

MINOR COUNTIES CHAMPIONSHIP.  
DEVON v. CORNWALL.

This match was continued at Tavistock on Thursday. Russell was taken in the slips without adding to his overnight score. Major Garrett left with 13 to his credit, and Davies with 21, Whiting taking both wickets. Burdett played brilliantly, scoring boundary after boundary with clock-work precision. After outling 55 minutes he reached the double century, but at 404 his great effort was brought to a close, Coad holding a skier from him at point. Altogether he was at the wicket 43 hours, and among his hits were eight sixes, 25 fours, and 5 threes. With the score at 419, the home county's innings was declared, Cornwall being left with 251 to get to save the innings defeat. Tresawna and Whitworth were the opening batsmen, and both played confidently, and scored rapidly. Thirty was reached when Whitworth fell to Russell, and eight runs later Tresawna was beaten. Fifty runs was hoisted in forty minutes, and Trevarthen had a few lucky hits, and then left. Coad was fifth out at 103, Bickford-Smith following at 117. Maunsell hit 4, 6, and a 2 before being caught at mid-off, but Burdett caught the next two men, and nine wickets were down for 137. The last two men hit out, and the innings closed for 151. Devon won by an innings and 100 runs.
