KENT V. WILTSHIRE.

On both occasions when a county eleven was playing at Malling last year, the Clerk of the Weather was in a bad mood, but on Wednesday and Thursday of last week he atoned for his past sins and provided glorious atmospheric conditions. Owing to various excursions, etc. there was not such a large crowd present at the Old County Cricket Ground to witness the match as might otherwise have been the case, still there were a good many who evidently preferred cricket to a day's outing to the sea or elsewhere. The scene was very picturesque on Wednesday afternoon, when Mr. C. J. Blackburn-Mase entertained a large company to tea on the ground. As to the play, wickets fell very fast at the commencement of the game, and at lunch time on Wednesday Kent, who had won the toss, were all out for 143, whilst Wiltshire had lost one wicket for four runs. On resuming Wiltshire were not long before they were dismissed for a total of 139, thus being four runs behind on the first innings. In their second innings Kent did much better, Troughton in particular distinguishing himself. He gave very few chances in compiling his 146, and his driving was splendid. Stumps were drawn at 6.30 with the score at 243 for five wickets. On Thursday the remaining Kent wickets fell for an addition of 111 runs, and Wiltshire at lunch time were all out for 106, Kent winning by 232 runs. Score and analysis:--
