HERTS v. NORFOLK.

Meeting the representatives of Norfolk on Tuesday and Wednesday, in the second match of the St. Albans Cricket Week, Hertfordshire found their batting form in such style as to gain a splendid victory. Apart from the absence of H. B. Cowley, Hertfordshire had their strongest batting team in the field. W. Bentley, who has been making good scores for West Herts, and H. F. Sanders, Hemel Hempstead's crick batsman, being included. Bentley is an exceptionally good fielder. Fortunate in securing first knock on a perfect batting wicket, and in brilliant weather, Herts opened their innings with J. O. Anderson and the Rev. F. R. Boney. The latter, Bentley, and C. H. Titchmarsh were all dismissed very cheaply, and three wickets were down for 24 runs. With the advent of Golding, however, the Norfolk bowlers met with no further success for a long time. After playing with great caution until 60 had been let behind, Anderson and Golding completely mastered the bowling, and runs were added at a good pace. When the former was finally given out the score, having styled cricket, Anderson had just passed the century. The arrival of Coleman heralded an even greater treat for the spectators. Hitting the bowling to all parts of the field, the fast bowler scored runs at a great rate, and with Golding's assistance he added 125 to the score before the latter was out in a manner similar to Anderson, and for a splendidly made 139. W. H. Marsh exhausted well, and the innings closed for 421, the runs having been obtained in four hours and three-quarters. Before stumps were drawn for the day, Norfolk scored 65 for the loss of three wickets. G. W. Birkbeck and the Rev. G. B. Baikes bating fairly well. On Wednesday morning, however, the remainder of the side fared disastrously before Coleman and Burton, and the innings closed for 162. Following on, Norfolk did better upon their second venture, thanks mainly to the brilliant batting of G. A. Stevens, whose powerful driving was the feature of the second day's play. Hitting a 6, a 5 and fifteen 4's, he was particularly severe on Burton. The score stood at 190 for five wickets, and Norfolk appeared to be putting up a good fight, when Burton changed the situation by bowling two batsmen in three balls, while at the other end, in the next over, one of Coleman's expressions was cricked by Stevens into the Herts wicketkeeper's safe hands. Coleman shattered Gilson's timber in the same over, and the end arrived at 4.30, Hertfordshire being the winners by an innings and 20 runs. Scores and analysis—
