BUCKS v. KENT SECOND.

This match was played on the ground of the Stoke Poges Golf Club at Farnham Royal on Wednesday and Thursday. Dr. E. Weaver-Adams and H. Jennison put on 50 for the first wicket of Bucks, but on Collins going on he had a sensational three overs, taking five wickets without a run being scored off him. B. H. G. Shaw played carefully at a critical period, and after luncheon P. L. Frith hit away merrily, and the innings closed for 145. Kent lost Capt. Sarel before a run had been scored, P. W. Le Gros bowling him first ball, but the Bucks total had been passed before the eighth wicket fell. A. F. Leach-Lewis and Roberts made a prolonged stand, and the total reached 235. Leach-Lewis's 53 included two 6's and six 4's. In the last quarter of an hour's play Bucks lost 3 wickets for 6 runs. Three-quarter of an hour's play on Thursday morning sufficed to finish the match. It was a masterly innings. Tarrant hit two 6's and twenty-seven 4's, and put on 129 for the fourth wicket with Hendren and 70 for the eighth with Saville. Notwithstanding mistakes in the field; Yorkshire could reply with no more than 218, Mignon being seen at his best. Booth played a most useful innings, and Drake helped him to add 58 and J. P.
