not out, and once caught. He was the popular and successful captain of the Harrow Eleven in 1865 and 1866, conducting much to their success by working the Eleven well, using his head equally with his hands, and combining even temper with judgment. . . . Height 5 ft 9½ in., and weight 12st." In 1863 the match with Eton was drawn, but in each of the following three Harrow won by an innings and over 50 runs. Mr. Stow's scores in these four games were 3, 54, 32 not out and 50, and among his Harrow contemporaries were Messrs. C. F. Buller, I. D. Walker, A. H. Hornby, W. B. Money, W. H. Hadow and F. C. Cobden. In the Harrow Alphabet of 1864 he was referred to in the following lines:—

"Stow and Smith—my verse now sings Stow, captain for next year;

Tremble, ye Etonians, he may well inspire fear." During three years—1867, 1868, and 1869—Mr. Stow was a member of the Cambridge Eleven, and in his last season had the satisfaction of captaining a side seven members of which—Messrs. Dale, Money, H. A. Richardson, Yardley, Thornton, Absalom and Brune—subsequently appeared for the Gentlemen against the Players. In the matches with Oxford he himself made only 56 runs in six innings, but he was on each occasion a member of the winning side.

Mr. Stow, in addition to being a fine cricketer, was a good rackets player, and in 1868 and 1870 represented his University against Oxford. He had been a member of the M.C.C. since 1884.

In 1865, when Mr. Stow succeeded the late C. F. Buller as captain of Harrow, the following lines—a parody on Hohenlinden—were written on that year's match with Eton:

On London when the sun was low
 All hoofless was the untrodden Row,
 And straight as arrow was the throw
 Of Amherst bowling rapidly.
 But London saw another sight
 When the bell rang at fall of night
 Commanding colours, dark and light,
 To quit the scenes of revelry.
 By tent and "Parry" fast parade
 Each horseman and each cockney blade,
 And furious every Dobbin neighed,
 To leave the noisy revelry.
 Then shook the air, with plaudits riven,
 Rushed off the swell to dinner driven,
 And, darker than the blue of heaven,
 Far flashed the blue millinery.
 But fiercer yet the steeds shall go
 O'er London's side of Rotten Row,
 And stronger yet the biceps throw,
 Of Amherst bowling rapidly.
 'Tis morn! and scarce Harrovian
 Can brook the chaff of Eton "don,"
 Where furious Frank and fiery John
 Shout 'neath heaven's sulphurous canopy.
 The combat ceases. On ye brave
 And rush to triumph, or to rave;
 Wave Harrow. All thy sisters wave,
 And cheer with all thy energy.
 Some few shall thousand voices greet;
 Our arms be their triumphal seat;
 And every boy that throngs their feet
 Re-echo Harrow's victory.
