RESUMÉ OF SEASON 1922.

IN every way the past season was a most satisfactory one, for not only did the County finish sixth out of twenty Counties, but the attendance at all the matches was very much in excess of anything we have seen before. On Saturday, June 10th, when Devon, with a team of Amateurs only, gained such a sensational victory over Surrey 2nd XI. (with no less than seven professionals on their side), the crowd was not only a record for the Pennsylvania ground, but its enthusiasm must have sent even the most rabid pessimist away happy for once. Why even a good many first class counties would have been pleased to have had such a large and sporting crowd!

But perhaps even a more satisfactory thing is that our debt is now cleared off, and we open the season on May 1st with a small balance in hand. For this state of things the subscribers to the County Club owe a big debt of thanks to their Committee and Area Representatives, who, by their energetic work in their respective areas, and regular attendance at Meetings, have seen that expenditure has been reduced to a minimum without sacrificing efficiency.

And now, what about the future?

Are we going to be content with things as they are, or are we going to launch out further?

The Committee are anxious to enlarge the programme to twelve matches instead of ten (the minimum is eight), so as to give subscribers a chance of seeing even more cricket: and it can easily be done if every member will try and get one more new subscriber. It is a question for each member to settle for himself, and we hope every one will say "more matches!"
