FEATS WITH BAT AND BALL.

The outstanding feature of a full programme of local cricket on Saturday was the compilation of another century—104 not out against Forest Amateurs—by D. W. Fletcher, the young Old Nottinghamians batsman.

# RARE FEAT IN CRICKET.

## LOCAL BOWLER'S DOUBLE HAT-TRICK.

### SECOND ELEVEN'S BIG SCORE.

It seldom happens that one or other of the Old Nottinghamians teams fail to accomplish something good with the bat—either collectively or individually—and last Saturday was no exception.

Their second eleven, against Gratham II, found themselves able to declare at the capital total of 291 for four, and a very fine second wicket partnership of 232 contributed largely to this end.

Their first wicket fell with only a single registered, but a different complexion was put on their batting at the association of W. H. Hinton and H. Davis. Each scored a century in excellent time.

Davis was only occupied 65 minutes over his three figures, and another 35 minutes to make his score 152 before being caught. Hinton did not make his runs at quite the same rapid rate, but his performance was a first-rate one.

And an H. B. Trinder (six for 12) and J. E. Wells (four for 17) proved practically unplayable with the ball, ably assisted by Gratham for 25. Old Nottinghamians secured a handsome victory.

Notable individual all-round feats on Saturday included H. Dixon's 63 runs and seven wickets for 15 runs for Blackburn's against Reader's, and J. Jukes' 58 not out and five for 26 for Kimberley Institute at the expense of Digby Colliery.

For Langley Mill II., H. Hartley scored 102, and the same player also took six wickets for 22 runs.

Bowlers secured a full share of honours during the day. One feat is worthy of special mention—and it includes the astonishing rarity, two hat-tricks. The cricketer to achieve this distinction is C. Whomsey, of T. Glover and Son, who did it in capturing the Gedling Old Boys' second team wickets for seven runs.

J. Falconbridge (Cranmer) captured three St. Catherine's wickets with his first three deliveries, his figures for the innings being four for 16; and another hat-trick was achieved by F. Grows (Addison-street Congregational) in dismissing Kelham College players for eight runs.

When H. Benson (Millers) bowled C. Smith (Carrington Robin Hood) he knocked a ball no less than 41 yards; and something yet far short of this is the driving of a ball for 39 yards by L. Mees (Forman's Athletic II.) when he bowled A. Wakefield (Beeston Old Boys II.).

It is quite evident that the Notts II v. Lancashire II match at Titchfield Park, Hucknall, which will be finished to-day, will not be the last of its kind to be held in the town. The officials and members of both teams were highly delighted with the ground and the response of the public. Although the first batsmen went out at 11.30 a.m. there were a large number of people to witness the opening stages of the game. Early in the afternoon the people made for the Park from all directions, and after the tea interval, although the Park staff had spared no pains in providing as much seating accommodation as possible, all the seats were occupied. The wicket, which has undergone inspection weekly from the head groundmen of the Notts. Club, was in splendid condition.

The afternoon visitors missed Gunn's fine effort of 75. After the fall of Keeton's wicket he was joined by Shipston, and the pair kept up a merry pace of run-getting, Gunn making his 50 runs in as many minutes. He was well on the way to the century when Rushton, who was bowling particularly well, took his wicket when 75. Shipston, missed at 83, continued to score freely, and completed his century when the score stood at 225. Although he had not been scoring at the same rate as Gunn, he was always sound, and, like the latter, treated Preston with little respect. Rushton eventually took his wicket after a fine innings of 115.

There was a big disappointment in store for the onlookers, F. W. Saxton falling to Rushton at the second delivery. The local player was not the only batsman to be bewildered by Rushton's bowling. Copley, who followed Saxton, and Voce, the last man in, leaving the wicket without scoring.

It is interesting to note that no catches were made during the Notts. innings, all being bowled except Harris and Hodgkinson, who were out lbw. Indeed, there were only three catches made in the first day's play, and of these J. Iremonger's effort in catching Booth of Lancashire, was particularly smart.

The Notts. 2nd score of 263 was regarded as a notable achievement, and there was only time left before tea for Halliday and Paynter to make 32 for 0. Continuing the pair brought the score to 50 before being separated, but after the fall of the fourth wicket, Booth was the only player who seemed at ease with the bowling of Hodgkinson and Voce, and he made his half century in the seventh wicket partnership with Dr. Holmes. The latter played a very steady game, remaining at the wicket 45 minutes to score seven.

**TO-DAY'S PLAY.**

The overnight total of Lancashire was brought from 152 to 169 by Rushton and Holroyd, the former being dismissed by a catch at extra cover by Harris.

In the Notts. second innings the Lancashire fielding was particularly good, and the Notts. batsmen found scoring difficult, Preston and Holroyd causing much trouble. Gunn was caught at 15, and Shipston was smartly stumped by Farrimond. Halliday dismissed Copley with a fine catch on the boundary, and the sixth wicket fell at 94. Matthews repeated his hit for six of the previous day, but the tail failed to increase the total to any great extent. The innings closed for 1.15 p.m. for 114.

F. W. Saxton, the local player, completed 17 before his wicket was taken.

### Minor Counties Championship.

#### BRILLIANT PLAY BY WORKSHOP AMATEUR.

#### WORKSHIRE COLTS DEFEATED AT WORKSHOP.

There was a most exciting finish to the Minor Counties Championship match, between Notts. colts and Yorkshire colts, which commenced on Monday and concluded on Tuesday, when Notts. claiming an extra half-hour, won by seven wickets, with five minutes to spare. The victory was largely due to the fine play of the Workshop amateur, G. F. H. Heane, and Staples (A.). Three wickets were down in the Notts. second innings for 114 runs, and the clock was winning when Staples joined Heane, who had confidently batted a varied attack for an hour and a half. It was Staples' big hitting—three times the ball was out of the ground—that made victory possible and, at the end of the day's play, he had made 63 and Heane 55. Heane had been at the wickets while the total was raised from 3 to 199—a great feat of endurance—and the crowd cheered the batsmen at the end of a very exciting finish.

A splendid wicket had been prepared—good enough for any county match—when the game started. By the way, one of the umpires was George Doughty (Skipton) the famous Yorkshire coach, who was George Hirst's predecessor.

There was a large attendance on both days. The Yorkshire skipper, Major R. C. Chichester Constable, won the toss and, of course, decided to take advantage of the wicket. Notts. were weakened by the absence of Voce, who was playing at Bradford, but included G. F. H. Heane and Richmond, the goosy bowler. Yorkshire included Eric Rawlin, the fast bowler, son of the old Middlesex pro. Barber and Shackleton opened the Yorkshire innings and Matthews, who bowled with Staples, with the second ball of his first over, upset the Gomersall man's stumps, but it was a no ball! The fast bowler was also unfortunate in his second over, when Barber gave Wheat a difficult chance behind the stumps. With his outstretched right hand close to the ground, he touched the ball but could not hold it. The mistake was not expensive for in Matthew's fourth over he upset Barber's stumps.

Making his second appearance for the Yorkshire Colts, H. Bedford, the Barnsley batsman, created a very favourable impression. Going in when three Yorkshire wickets had fallen for 42, Bedford faced the bowling of experienced county players like Matthews, Staples and Richmond with remarkable assurance. Very quick to make up his mind, nimble-footed, and with a large variety of strokes at his command, he batted with an unhurried ease, which was highly attractive to watch. He made 50 in 45 minutes and scored a faultless 50, whilst his partner Grimshaw, was making 21.

Grimshaw, unfortunately, was not at his best, and was helped by two mistakes in the field, but his resourceful defence enabled him to keep Bedford company in an invaluable stand of 93 for the fourth wicket.

For his last turn with the ball Staples had the splendid analysis of 10.2 overs, 5 maidens, 15 runs and six wickets. The last five Yorkshire wickets fell for only 21 runs, and the total of 165 was disappointing.

Bedford's display had a counterpart of exactly the same value in a really delightful innings for Notts by G. V. Gunn. Besides greatly resembling his father in appearance, this son of George Gunn has inherited or acquired all his father's grace of style at the wicket, plus a youthful enterprise, which enabled him to make 50 in 47 minutes.

The bowling of Douglas and Render was severely punished, Notts. sending up the 1st in an hour for the loss of two wickets. Major Chichester-Constable then gave Bedford a prolonged try out with the ball. He is a bowler of the goosy type, and obviously was able to get a good deal of spin on the ball, but he proved decidedly expensive. Nevertheless he tempted two good batsmen, Gunn and G. F. Heane, into being caught and bowled. With only five wickets down Notts. passed the Yorkshire total, the bowling of the visitors against men who were well set being made to appear altogether lacking in sting. When stumps were drawn Notts. with a wicket to fall, were 73 runs ahead.

Wood, the Yorkshire wicket-keeper, had an uncomfortable experience. While batting, a ball from Staples ran up his bat and struck him on the jaw, breaking a tooth, which Wood, in his surprise, swallowed.

Five balls were enough to finish the Notts. innings on Tuesday. The fourth was sent by Matthews to the boundary but, with the fifth, Rawlin uprooted his off stump. Notts. had a lead of 77.

Barber and Shackleton had scored 39 when the Keighley man was out to a decision he did not like. With four added, Turner, the new comer was bowled so that Richmond, without a victim on Monday, got the first two on Tuesday. Barber joined by Grimshaw, was missed in the slips and the Horsforth man behind the wicket, both off Matthews, but they knocked off the Yorkshire arrears. Barber reached his 50 in an hour and 25 minutes, but, with the score at 94, he provided the goosy bowler with his third wicket.

Without any addition to the score, a further disaster befell Yorkshire on the resumption, Bedford being stumped. Richmond then bowled Grimshaw and half the Yorkshire side were out for 115. Grimshaw had batted with exemplary care for an hour and 16 minutes. But the hour found the man—Wood, who reached 102 before he was out to a great catch by Heane. He had batted an hour and 15 minutes, reaching his second 50 in 35 minutes.

The side were out for 275, leaving Notts. two hours to get 199 to win.

They were given a splendid start, after Taylor left at 23, Gunn scoring an attractive 54. He left, however at 50, and his captain joined Heane. The seventeen years old Leeds bowler got his wicket at 114 and then came the great stand and the big victory. Scores:—
