

## SECOND TIE IN SUCCESSION

### Yorkshire Council Coincidence: C. Nuttal Takes 7 for 11

Denaby and Cadeby have played two home matches in the Yorkshire Council and the second, against Scarborough, finished like the first, in a tie—a remarkable sequence. And although such was the result, the spectators and players were not aware of it. They thought that although the match was drawn, Denaby had actually scored one more run, but when the scorers checked their totals, they discovered that both sides had similar scores.

For the loss of 12 wickets nearly 500 runs were scored, Denaby declaring at 243 for four. Their chief scorer was E. Wainwright, who, after being missed when 14, went on to score 97. Three other players also reached or topped the 50.

Champion, the veteran slow bowler, foiled a fine Altofts bid for victory in the match between Altofts and Leeds Zingari. Set to get 214 to win in just over two hours, Altofts, finely led by Bednall, who compiled a polished 68, appeared to be rushing to a spectacular success when Champion was brought on. In six overs Champion conceded 43 runs, but he had the satisfaction of claiming five wickets. Zingari, who won by 16 runs, were also greatly indebted to Jackson, a newcomer, who made 119 in two hours.

Glass Houghton gained a striking victory at home against Knaresborough, for after Knaresborough had declared at 188 for seven wickets, Glass Houghton passed this score with the loss of only one batsman. Almond, with 57, was top scorer for Knaresborough, but the batting honours were carried off by T. Didlock, who hit up a brilliant unfinished 107 for the winners. His strokes included five sixes and ten fours.

#### Seven Wickets for 11 Runs

South Kirkby Colliery's victory by 10 wickets over Featherstone was mainly attributable to the deadly bowling of C. Nuttal, who took seven wickets for eleven runs in thirteen overs, seven of which were maidens. Nuttal, was ably supported by S. Johnson, who took the last two wickets for four runs in two overs and four balls. Only one batsman on the Featherstone side (P. Moxon 18 not out) reached double figures, and the innings was over in an hour. Fifteen minutes sufficed for H. Walsh and J. Smart to pass the Featherstone total.

A bright batting display by H. Perkins was largely responsible for Thornhill being able to declare against Elsecar with a total of 232 for eight wickets. The Elsecar batsmen were unable to make much headway, only Lax (not out 45) showing confidence, but Thornhill were deprived of what appeared to be a certain victory by the time limit.

An astonishing collapse by Firbeck Main was seen at South Elmsall, where Frickley Colliery won by 80 runs. Three Frickley men, A. Ward (48) and T. Smith (44), who had an opening partnership of 71, and L. S. Dyson (43) batted well, while C. Burkinstone was at the wicket only ten minutes for his 31, hitting two 6's, and two 4's in one over. Firbeck's opening pair J. Hutchinson (36) and H. Sherwin (30) put on 65, but the next four men added only nine runs, and the last three the same number, the team being out for 133. Frickley's slow bowler, A. Ward, did the damage by taking five for 30.

Rossington Main struck winning form with a comfortable home victory against Hemsworth. The Main side lost three wickets for 27, but Griffiths pulled matters round, and his 66 included six boundaries. Kelley, who was ninth in, provided a lively interlude, making 33 in a quarter of an hour, including a six and four boundaries. Webster had a splendid spell of bowling for Rossington and took six wickets for 31.

Wadsworth, the ex-Doncaster Rovers and Scunthorpe footballer, was in good form with the bat for Rawmarsh when they defeated Brodsworth by 92 runs. He made 54, the highest score of his side, in a total of 201. Earshaw's six wickets for 29 was a big help in Brodsworth's defeat.

## FEAST OF RUNS IN HEPWORTH CUP

Gildersome Total Sets Up  
a New Record

### "FIREWORKS" AT METHLEY

The first round ties for the Hepworth Challenge Cup, produced plenty of thrilling cricket in spite of the cold wind and threatening skies, and the enthusiastic few who turned up to watch the games were pleasantly excited.

At Methley, the visiting North Leeds bowlers were soon successful, the first four home batsmen making only 30 runs; but the Rev. J. H. L. Phillips, a prominent Rugby Union footballer, indulged in some big hitting to rally Methley's score. In quick time, he scored 13 boundaries in an innings of 73, and then came the "big moment" of the match when N. Grayson, number nine in the batting order, took the crease. He belaboured the North Leeds bowling to such purpose that Phillips's merry innings lost much of its glamour. Grayson pulled and drove delightfully, and in 70 minutes reached his 100, which included 76 runs from boundaries. Methley in the end totalled 281. North Leeds were confident that their batting was strong enough to make a fight of it; but Grayson (3 for 4) and R. Elliott (5 for 13) bowled superbly, and North Leeds were out for only 66 runs.

A. Cooper (67) and H. Hunt (40) batted in confident mood for Leeds Police at Headingley, and put on 97 runs for the first wicket; but T. A. Booth, the veteran Leeds all-rounder, caused a collapse, and the Police were all out for 154. Booth claiming seven for 27. Leeds won by three wickets.

L. Carter, of Middleton Park, made half the Lofthouse side for 18 runs, but A. Pope, hit out for a brisk 30 runs, and the Lofthouse innings reached 93. Middleton Park had five wickets in hand when they passed this total. Calverley had an even bigger win when they received East Ardsley, who made 163. A. Dibb then scored a polished 50 and Calverley won by seven wickets.

Good all-round bowling enabled Shadwell to beat Rothwell by three wickets margin, R. F. Charge (3 for 16), G. W. Horner (3 for 9), and W. Bates (3 for 23) dismissing the home side for 80.

Two bowlers each had five victims in the Kirkstall Educational-Woodhouse match at Meanwood, but neither of the Skirrows, who have done wonderful things for Kirkstall this season, "came off." Kirkstall totalled 146. F. Thompson taking five wickets for 38 runs, and then J. Barron had a spell to help in the dismissal of Woodhouse for 123, claiming five for 45.

A new record was set up for the Hepworth Cup by Gildersome, who put together 319 at Castleford, this exceeding by one run the previous record held by East Leeds. Gildersome batted four and a half hours, Newell and Coupe being associated in a stand which realised 184 runs for the second wicket. Newell missed his century by one and Coupe was seven short. In such a large total C. Tyson's bowling analysis of six wickets for 70 must be counted a meritorious performance. Castleford had replied with 10 for the loss of one wicket when the game was adjourned until to-night at 6.30.
